## Eligibility

To make a claim for fuel tax credits you must be registered for:

- GST when you acquired the fuel; and
- fuel tax credits when you lodge the claim.

*Note: If you have not registered for fuel tax credits, registration can be backdated to the date of your GST registration or the 1st July 2006 (when fuel tax credits commenced).*

## Eligible Fuels

You can claim fuel tax credits for eligible liquid or gaseous fuels. Do you use any of the following fuels in your vehicles?

### Liquid Fuels

- Petrol
- Diesel
- Blended fuels (B5, B20, E10)

### Transport Gaseous Fuels

- Liquefied petroleum gas (LPG)
- Liquefied natural gas (LNG)
- Compressed natural gas (CNG)

## Eligible Activities

You can claim fuel tax credits for any or all of the activities noted below. If you perform the activity but aren't claiming the rebates noted then you may be owed money and should contact us ASAP.

### Activity

- Do you have heavy vehicles using petrol, diesel or blended fuels that travel on public roads?
- Do you have heavy vehicles using petrol, diesel or blended fuels that are powering auxiliary equipment that travel on public roads?
- Do you have heavy or light vehicles using petrol, diesel or blended fuels that travel off public roads?
- Do you have heavy or light vehicles using LPG that travel off public roads?
- Do you have heavy or light vehicles using LNG or CNG that travel off public roads?

### Claim

- Are you claiming the on-road rate of 16.5 cents per litre?
- Are you claiming the off-road rate of 42.3 cents per litre for a portion of the on-road usage?
- Are you claiming the off-road rate of 42.3 cents per litre for all off public road usage?
- Are you claiming the off-road rate of 13.8 cents per litre for all off public road usage?
- Are you claiming the off-road rate of 29.0 cents per litre for all off public road usage?

## Record Keeping

- Have you kept detailed records of the date and quantity of fuel you have acquired?
- Do your records show details of your fuel use?
- Do your records prove your eligibility for fuel tax credits?
- Do you have copies of your historical fuel tax credit claims?
